Smoking at a Stranger's Home.

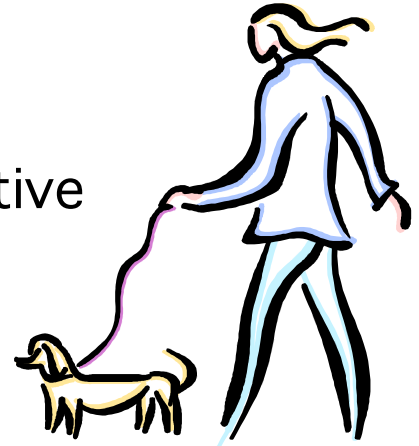
Until You Get Permission,
